The table below outlines some of the possible homework tasks that students may be asked to complete during this half term

Year group	Topics Students will be learning	Description of homework tasks
7	Fairground and Circus	-Complete the 'Fairground and Circus' drawing sheet. The sheet has three separate tasks and you must complete one task every two weeks.
8	Shoes and Laces	-Complete the 'Shoes and Laces' drawing sheet. The sheet has three separate tasks and you must complete one task every two weeks.

10 New	Explore the theme of 'Identity & Disguise'. Drawing Skills Collection Homework	-Present a full page collage in your sketchbook relating to the theme of 'Identity and Disguise'. You will need to look for images on the internet, in magazines, books and newspapers. Please use lunch time art club if you do not have access to the internet or a printer at home. -Produce 1 x detailed pencil study of a facial feature (eye, lips, nose, ear). Use the facial features resource sheet for guidance. -Collect a variety of objects from home that represent your identity. Objects could include jewellery, make-up, tickets from travel, photographs, memorabilia from holidays, concert or match tickets
10	Urban Environment and Architecture	-Complete the SAIL task from your last assessment - Collect card board, straws, wire, wire mesh, etc. Use the materials you have collected to add interest and depth to 'Urban Environment' final piece.
