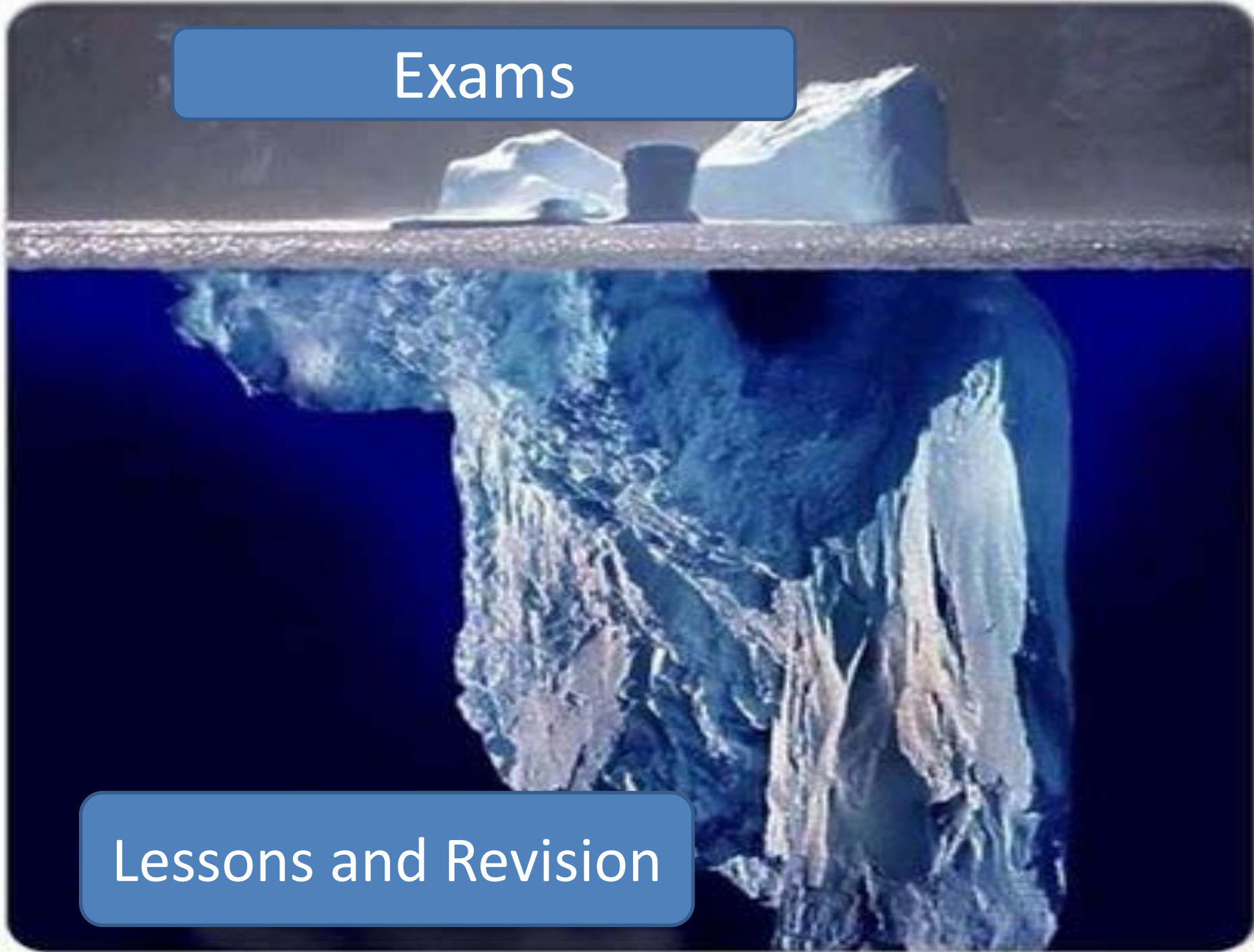
- ▶ **Mock exams – En, Ma + Sc 16th October**

Assertive Mentoring

- ▶ **Some pupils** in Year 11 have a mentor
- ▶ **Direct** style mentoring focusing on pupil progress and attainment.
- ▶ Systems that **do not allow pupils to escape their responsibility**
- ▶ DC **reports inform** the meetings and focus
- ▶ The mentor determines **targets** and supports pupils to meet them
- ▶ The mentor will have two meetings with their mentee (pupil) every half term
- ▶ A meeting record sheet in quadruplicate is used

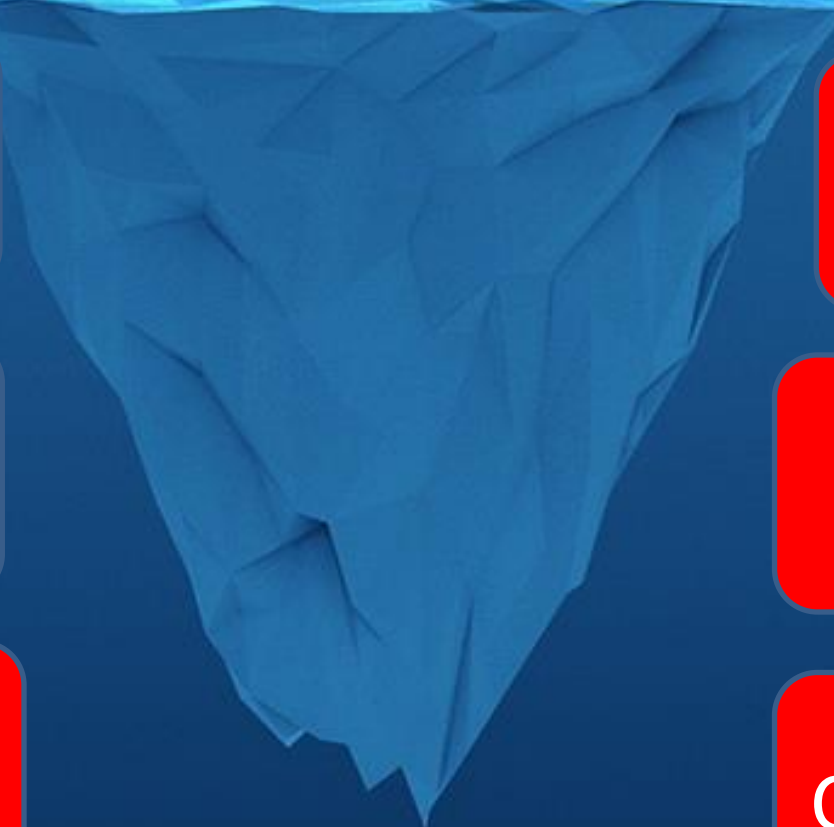
