'Know more, Do more, Remember More'

At Birches Head Academy we believe that the neuroscience behind working memory and long-term knowledge retention plays a key part in how students learn. Therefore our curriculum design is underpinned by the concept of 'know more, do more, remember more'. This is the assertion that students need a solid understanding of core knowledge if they are going to progress in their learning.

Our pedagogy aligns with our knowledge rich curriculum. It emphasises recurrent knowledge retrieval, which we embed in our model as the Do Now at the start of every lesson. We prioritise modelling and scaffolding to ensure students understand the work, thus ensuring they are well prepared for independent practice which leads to achievement.
