Pupils will study the Spanish city of Barcelona and will explore the culture and tourist attractions of the city. They will learn how to make a reservation in a hotel and how to deal with problems when travelling.	Pupils will study the topic of life in school and will express opinions about school subjects, teachers, facilities and school rules. They will use the past, present and future tenses. Pupils will discuss extra curricular activities and will learn how to plan for an exchange trip and communicate with a Spanish family.	Pupils will study the topic of relationships and social media. They will express advanced opinions of social media debating the advantages and disadvantages of communicating online.
