	<i>Knowledge</i>	Pupils will know why politics is important and how our country is run. They will understand the role of the Prime Minister and the role of the Monarchy, whilst also exploring political debating, elections, and campaigning.	Pupils will explore how Britain is multicultural. They will explore the importance of being king whilst learning about learning disabilities, prejudices, and discrimination and how to challenge islamophobia.	Pupils will continue to look at change focusing on sleep and relaxation, their finances and transition points in their lives. During this LP they will move into Puberty and Body Development looking at girls' and boys' puberty, personal hygiene and growing up including the 'your body' rules.	Pupils will finish Puberty Body Development by looking at self-esteem, tooth decay and dental health. Pupils will explore consent and boundaries, respect in relationships. They will examine what makes a good friend and online relationships; they will know why it is important to be positive, but also know how to respond to pressure, influence, and friendships.	The final topic of the year will focus on avoiding gangs and criminal behaviour; and online gaming, grooming and addiction. Pupils will understand the risks associated with alcohol nicotine, smoking and vaping, energy drinks and nicotine. Pupils will also consider knife crime and their own safety.

	<i>Knowledge</i>	Pupils will begin by looking at 'Desert Island Living' building a community and making decisions. They will then explore the criminal justice systems and how laws are made before exploring prisons, reform and punishments and forming their own opinions on society.	Pupils will look at LGBTQ+ rights across the world, they will explore gender equality, ableism and disability discrimination, racism, and discrimination. Pupils will explore how we remove barriers and create equality for all. During this LP pupils will move onto Proud to be Me looking specifically at employability and enterprise skills, careers and aspirations and exploring a wide variety of careers.	Pupils will finish this unit by looking at their self-esteem and how it is influenced by the media; the importance of happiness and understanding what makes them angry and how to respond to it. During this LP they will move into Physical Health and Mental Wellbeing looking at what mental health is, having a positive body image. They will identify signs of child abuse and explore the different types of bullying and know where to access support to deal with any issues.	Pupils will finish Physical Health and Mental Wellbeing by looking at cholesterol, healthy eating, and stress management. Pupils will then look at ways they can be themselves and be happy in themselves, explore healthy relationships and the concept of love, knowing ways to deal with conflict. They will look at using contraception and explore different sexual orientations.	Pupils will explore the concept on County Lines and substance misuse; they will explore cyberbullying and online grooming and child exploitation. Finally, pupils will look at the risks of alcohol and the consequences of over consumption.

They will be looking at what terrorism is and the radicalisation process, as well as exploring ow counter terrorism works. Pupils will also explore what Anti-Semitism is.	Pupils have already looked at sexual consent and the law and will explore why people have sex. They will look at relationships, partners and domestic abuse and violence. They will also be aware of FGM, sexual harassment and stalking and the laws surrounding them. During this LP pupils will move onto Essential Life Skills looking at turning failures into successes, assertiveness, and social media online stress.	Pupils will finish this topic by looking at saving and managing money, understanding what Labour Market Information is, and applying finance and budgeting to employment. During this LP they will begin looking at Body Confidence by looking at self-esteem, the media and airbrushing. Exploring bullying in all its forms and dealing with grief and loss.	Pupils will finish looking at Body Confidence by looking at cancer prevention and healthy lifestyles then exploring the penis and vulva before moving into their second RSE topic. During this LP pupils will know what STIs, preventing and treating them. They will explore different forms of contraception and their effectiveness as well as understand HIV and AIDS and the prejudice and discrimination surrounding them	Pupils will finish the year looking at the different types of addiction, cannabis products and drugs classifications. They will look at party drugs, volatile substance abuse and how the 'war on drugs' is being tackled on a global level.
