	<i><b>Knowledge</b></i>	Pupils will begin the year by looking at British Values, Identity and Human Rights, exploring Mutual Respect and Tolerance, and Individual Liberty. Pupils will look at Hate Crime in the UK before exploring how to identify fake news and think critically.	Having looked at International Organisations, pupils will move onto Peace, War and Conflict before exploring Human Rights during war and how we offer aid and support to other countries. Pupils will look at women's rights, equality, and fair and free trade. During this LP they will move onto <b>Rights and Responsibilities</b> looking specifically at moral duties, consumer, and employer rights.	Pupils will continue this topic by looking at marriage, the Insta and Tik-Tok generation and how our data is used to target advertising. During this LP pupils will begin looking at <b>Mental Health and Wellbeing</b> by exploring what mental health issues are, how screen time can impact mental health, self-harm, and suicidal thoughts.	Pupils will finish <b>Mental Health and Wellbeing</b> by exploring how to promote their emotional wellbeing and then looking at issues surrounding child abuse. For <b>RSE</b> they will look at delaying sexual activity, campaigning against FGM and the impact of sexualisation of the media. They will look at the risks of sexting, the influence of porn on society and laws regarding sexual assault and rape.	Pupils will finish the year exploring how to stay safe by understanding what honour-based violence is and what forced marriage and breast ironing are. They will look at online gaming and gambling, as well as keeping their data safe. Finally exploring modern day slavery and the causes of knife crime.

Pupils will continue this topic by looking at love, respect and relationships, and peer on peer abuse. They will explore fertility and what impacts it, the importance of sexual health and STIs and contraception. During this LP they will begin <b>Your Future and Beyond</b> by looking at social media in comparison to real life, screen addiction and studying, as well as exam stress and anxiety.	Pupils will finish this topic by looking at their Post 16 options, how to write a CV and producing a personal statement. During this LP they will begin <b>Adult Health and Looking After Yourself</b> by looking at love and abuse, teenage pregnancy choices, abortion laws, morals and ethics and parenthood for teenagers.	Pupils will finish <b>Health and Looking After Yourself</b> by looking at male and female cancers as well as blood and organ donation. They will begin <b>Staying Safe</b> by looking at virtual reality and live streaming, online reputation and digital footprints, group chats and anti-bullying. Pupils will look at cosmetic procedures, psychoactive substances and substance addition.
