I will show gratitude by saying please and thank you.</p> <p>What will I be learning about in this Learning Programme? The reign of the Tudors, from Henry Tudor to Elizabeth I. How the balance of power and religion changed during this period and the consequences on economic and social aspects.</p> <p>Where have I seen this learning before?
