<p>What will I be learning about in this Learning Programme? LP5 will see you develop your fundamental skills of throwing and catching in striking and fielding sports including rounders, cricket and softball.</p> <p>Where have I seen this learning before? In LP3/4 you learned the fundamental movement skills of throwing and catching. These skills are transferable to LP5 where you will look at ways to improve your accuracy and power when throwing and consistency when catching.</p> <p>What could I use it for? In BTEC sport Unit 5 you will look at the sports performer in action and how the body works in sport. It is important that you have a good understanding of numerous sports to be able to make accurate athlete comparisons in your coursework.</p>
